FIRE EXTINGUISHER REGULATIONS FOR OFF ROAD VEHICLES

REFERENCE:

2005 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Section 12, General Requirements for Off Road Vehicles, GR 11, page 12 - 20

RATIONALE:

To amend GR 11 FIRE EXTINGUISHER to increase the capacity of the fire extinguisher/s in off road cars.

AUTHORITY:

This amendment was approved by the Australian Off Road Commission 6th November 2004.

ACTION:

Amend GR 11 Fire Extinguisher as follows;

Each vehicle must be equipped with a **one or more hand held** fire extinguisher/s complying with ~~AS 1841, or AS 1846 or AS 1848~~ of at least 900g capacity **a standard listed in Schedule H, with a combined capacity of 1.8kg.**

A plumbed in system homologated by the FIA may be fitted in addition to the above.

~~Note that~~ The use of BCF extinguishers is now prohibited.
