

## SPORTING BULLETIN

### 2005 AUSTRALIAN OFF ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP SPORTING REGULATIONS – START ORDER

#### **REFERENCE:**

*Bulletin B05/003 & 2005 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Section 12 Off Road Championship Sporting Regulations, Article 4.2, page 12 – 9.*

#### **RATIONALE:**

*To clarify the start order of Australian Off Road Championship events.*

#### **AUTHORITY:**

*This amendment was approved by the Australian Off Road Commission by email on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2005.*

#### **ACTION:**

That item 2 of Bulletin B005/03 (Article 4.2 of the AORC Sporting Regulations) be amended as follows:

".....same respective positions.

The starting order for Section 2 and all subsequent sections will be based on the finishing order for the preceding section, ~~as varied by any seeding of competitors who failed to finish an earlier section~~ **progressive results of the event (preferred) or the finishing order on the track for Section 1, as varied by any seeding of competitors who failed to finish an earlier section. In the case of events incorporating more than two sections, for sections following section 2 the starting order shall be based on the progressive results of the event, as varied by any seeding of competitors who failed to finish an earlier section."**
